## **Adult Feed Cloth Pattern**

## **CUTTING OUT**

1. Cut a towel crosswise into two or three pieces. This will depend on size and condition of towel.

Each cloth needs to be:

Width Length 40cm - 45cm 61cm - 70cm (16" - 18") (24" - 27")

2. Fold over one end of towel 18cm (7"). Divide fold line into thirds and mark.

3. Cut a semi circle of 10cm (4") radius from the centre third.



## **Neckline**

 Cut ribbing or other suitable stretch fabric 50cm(20") long (across greatest stretch) and approx. 7cm (3") wide. With right sides together, sew ends together.



**2.** Fold in half being sure to have edges together.

Divide ribbing into quarters and mark with pins.

3. Divide neckline into quarters and mark with pins.





 Having the ribbing seam at the centre back of the feed cloth, pin ribbing to feed cloth, right sides together and matching all pins. Stretch to fit as necessary.



5. Sew ribbing to neckline with an overlocking stitch.



## **FINISHING**

Finish all edges of feed cloth as required. This could be with binding, overlock edge then turn and stitch down, lace trim – whatever takes your fancy.
