



Adult Feed Cloth Pattern

CUTTING OUT

<p>1. Cut a towel crosswise into two or three pieces. This will depend on size and condition of towel.</p>	<p>Each cloth needs to be:</p> <table><tr><td>Width</td><td>Length</td></tr><tr><td>40cm - 45cm (16" - 18")</td><td>61cm - 70cm (24" - 27")</td></tr></table>	Width	Length	40cm - 45cm (16" - 18")	61cm - 70cm (24" - 27")

<p>2. Fold over one end of towel 18cm (7"). Divide fold line into thirds and mark.</p> <p>3. Cut a semi circle of 10cm (4") radius from the centre third.</p>					




Neckline

<p>1. Cut ribbing or other suitable stretch fabric 50cm(20") long (across greatest stretch) and approx. 7cm (3") wide. With right sides together, sew ends together.</p>	
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<p>2. Fold in half being sure to have edges together. Divide ribbing into quarters and mark with pins.</p> <p>3. Divide neckline into quarters and mark with pins.</p>		
<p>4. Having the ribbing seam at the centre back of the feed cloth, pin ribbing to feed cloth, right sides together and matching all pins. Stretch to fit as necessary.</p>		
<p>5. Sew ribbing to neckline with an overlocking stitch.</p>		

FINISHING

Finish all edges of feed cloth as required. This could be with binding, overlock edge then turn and stitch down, lace trim – whatever takes your fancy.
